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Importer Security Filing (ISF) About

Regulation Proposed by Customs & Border Protection (CBP)

- Grew out of the Safe Port Act
- Aims to further insulate the United States from terrorist threats
- Relies on sets of data that will be analyzed prior to vessel arrival



Importer Security Filing (ISF) About

Required for Ocean Import Containers

- "10+2" data must be transmitted to CBP 24 hours prior to loading container on vessel
- CBP will issue an approval or rejection of the security filing
- After the flexibility period, fines will be issued and "Do Not Load" orders sent



Importer Security Filing (ISF) What Information is Required?

Importer Data Set (Transmitted 24 Hours Prior to Loading)

- Manufacturer
- Seller
- Buyer
- Container Stuffing Location
- Consolidator
- Ship To
- Importer of Record
- Consignee
- Country of Origin
- HTUSA Classification-6 Digit
- *all of the above require name, address, and for U.S. companies, IRS numbers



Importer Security Filing (ISF) What Information is Required?

Vessel Operator Filing (transmitted 48 hours after sailing)

- Vessel stowage plan
- Log of significant planned moves of each container



Importer Security Filing (ISF) How to transmit the data

- The ABI or AMS system must be used to electronically transmit the data
- Importer can self-file or designate an agent to file on behalf of importer
- Agents can be brokers/forwarders





Importer Security Filing (ISF) How to prepare

Compliance & Solutions

- Speak with trade industry contacts
- Contact surety company regarding bond riders
- Read relevant literature
- Compile data now
- Determine who will be the filer
- Communicate



Importer Security Filing (ISF) Summary

- Importers must comply beginning 1/26/09
- Action Customs is evaluating various solutions
- Importer must contact overseas business partners in order to have necessary data available for input 72 hours prior to container loading
